

Export Licence Statistics

The Control of Exports Act, 2008 provides the legal basis for export controls, the licensing regime and the overall regulatory environment relating to the export of dual use and military goods. In addition, a number of directly effective EU Regulations regulate the export of these goods from the EU.

The objective of providing an annual report under the Act is to provide the public with a much greater level of transparency about exports of controlled goods and services, and an understanding of how export control operates.

To provide more regular information about exports of controlled goods, the Minister decided to publish summary, interim data on the Department's website.

The summary data in the Table below for the second 6 months of 2012 is preliminary and subject to verification and change.
