The new Chair, Ms. Marian Cassidy, Department of Enterprise, Trade and Employment (DETE) gave an introduction and welcomed working group members to the meeting.

Item 2: Presentation by Retail Ireland Skillnet

Ms. Theresa Gallagher, Retail Ireland Skillnet provided an update on the Apprenticeship in Retail Supervision programme and the Degree in Retail Management Practice.

Item 3: Working Group Actions

The Chair updated members on the Working Group Actions. A lot of progress has been made and all 9 Actions related to the Digitalisation and Skills working group have been dealt with. A new work Programme will be developed by September, and the Secretariat will be in contact with Working Group members bilaterally in relation to the new Work Programme.
