Note of meeting

Ross Church opened the meeting and asked if there was any queries or observations on the Terms of Reference. There was a short discussion around operational contact and updating the hub. A discussion around a bilingual site and signposting to and from the Hub was also had. Darren O'Reilly (Enterprise Ireland) advised that work on the Irish side of the site is in progress.

It was agreed to amend the TOR to include reference to the Irish language version of the site. The TOR will be recirculated to the group for observations and if none were received by Friday, 21 June it would be taken as agreed and circulated for signature.

Brian Smith and Paul Caplis (Enterprise Ireland) then gave a presentation on the National Enterprise Hub and also gave members of the group a virtual tour of the website.

It was noted that there will be a live chat feature and chatbot available for out of hours queries.

Further testing of the system was to take place in the afternoon. It was noted that Work is also underway for the development of a live feature to adverting current events. The group then had a discussion around agency involvement and the order supports are featured on the website. Also, discussed were the data/stats that could be made available following go live date. It was noted that it would be useful to have data/stats at the quarterly meetings of the group.

Conor O'Donovan (Enterprise Ireland) then gave the group a rundown of the day of the launch and the media campaign around the launch.
