Item 1: Welcome

The Chair welcomed attendees.

Item 2: Presentation from the National Town Centre First Office with an update on Town Centre First Policy

- TCF Office updated members on progress of actions under the Town Centre First Initiative with 15 of the 33 actions completed and 7 actions in hand.
- TCFO referred to Action 12 of the TCF Identify agreed data measurement requirements with respect to social and economic outcomes, digitalisation skills and climate action - regarding collection of data from towns and how to measure data in terms of economic output.
- TFCO informed members present that the TCF Office are about to engage consultants to look at this. This project is also linked to the development of a data portal which is expected in Q1 2025.

Comments Arising:

 Member noted that there are data projects being undertaken in Ireland and other countries that collect data on various data points.

Actions:

DETE to invite members to submit feedback to TCFO on this action.

Item 3: Presentation on Meanwhile Use legislation for vacant buildings.

- Department of Housing Local Government and Heritage (DHLGH) presented on this topic.
- DHLGH is seeking feedback from relevant stakeholders on their paper on meanwhile use legislation for vacant buildings with a view to its potential application in Ireland.
- The current consultation and engagement with various sectors (deadline 27 September for feedback) seeks to further examine the issues that impact on meanwhile.

Comments Arising:

- From earlier consultation it was noted that the commercial rates system may be a disincentive to meanwhile use.
- The licencing system may be more appropriate than the planning system.
- Sometimes negative perception of pop-ups.
- Links to UK examples in the document circulated. Meanwhile use lease and guidance - GOV.UK (www.gov.uk)
- Member detailed two previous experiences of meanwhile use in Ireland.
- One member noted that there is a need to provide incentive to landlords when approaching vacant commercial property owners.
- o Mixed-use properties and bank lending was raised.

Actions:

Members invited to submit feedback on consultation by 27 September to DHLGH.

Item 4: Update from NTE unit in DTACGSM

The Night-time Economy unit provided an update on progress of actions in the Plan.

- 29 actions of 36 completed
- 15 actions are ongoing
- NTE unit are doing some work on the data collection piece and are liaising with the TCF office.
- Meanwhile use is also an action in the NTE. It has been reported that a high level of vacancy gives rise to a perception of lack of safety.

Comments Arising:

 A member commented on the work of the Night-time Economy advisors and wished to compliment them.
