The Economic Partnership Agreement (EPA) is a trade agreement between the EU and Japan which came into force on 1st February 2019.

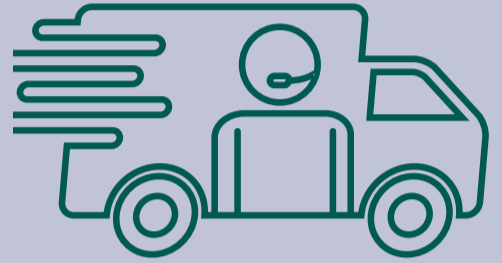

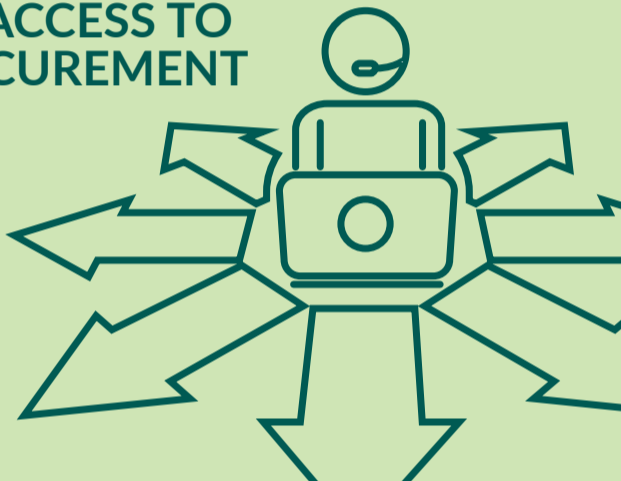

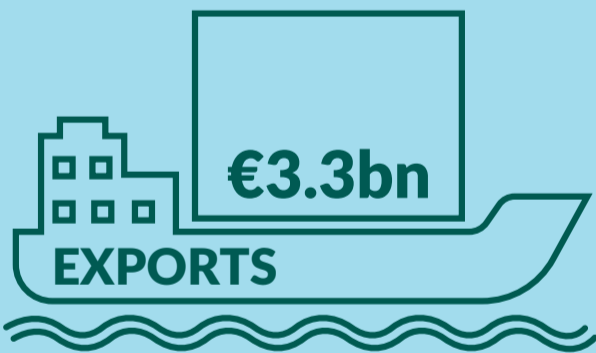

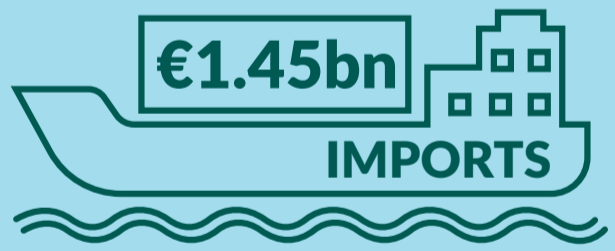
